Week beginning: Monday 27th January 2025

Maths	In maths, we will be starting to learn about fractions. We will be identifying what a fraction is and the different ways that we can make a whole. Also, we will be learning in a bit more detail at hundredths, following on from previous learning of tenths.
English	In English, we will be beginning our innovate stage of our playscript text. The children will be creating their own playscripts based upon the model text, Goldilocks and the Three Bears.
Science	In science, the children will be observing and interacting with reversible and irreversible states of matter.
Integrated Curriculum	In Topic, continuing with our Ancient Greek scheme of work, we will be learning about the Ancient Olympic Games.




We value your continued support in working together to ensure your child makes the best progress. Therefore our next parent workshop is 'Staying Active'.
