Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 27th January 2025

Maths	The children will continue to deepen their understanding of fractions next week. They will be learning how to convert improper fractions to mixed numbers. Then, they will be learning how to convert mixed numbers to improper fractions.
English	In writing, the children will start to use everything they have learnt about instructional texts to write their own, using a guided write from the teacher.
Science	Next week, the children will be planning and conducting a fair test using air resistance by designing and testing parachutes. They will then be learning about the benefits of levers and will label the parts of a seesaw, explaining how they work.
Integrated Curriculum	We have an exciting week ahead for our topic lessons! The children will be learning about different types of volcanoes before having a go at making their own.




We value your continued support in working together to ensure your child makes the best progress. Therefore our next parent workshop is 'Staying Active'.


