Maths	This week, we will continue our exploration of measurements, focusing on shapes with the same area. Following this, we will move on to learning how to calculate the area of triangles.
English	Writing - This week we will be identifying and creating sentences of 3 for action, identifying features of a warning story, creating a warning story toolkit and analysing effective sentences.
Science	In science this week students will be exploring and investigating reflection. In class they will learn about incident rays, angles of reflection, etc. and in the lab they will complete practical tasks demonstrating their knowledge and understanding.
