## Year 1 learning:

### Week beginning: Monday 3rd February

This week, we will continue with our Meerkat Mail text during our Talk 4 Writing lessons. We will revisit the text daily and will use our own actions to it to help us remember the text. We will then complete our own ideas for the whole of the text. We will use our plans to help to compose our sentences.

In maths, we will complete our number work and focus on counting in multiples. We will begin the week by counting in 2's and then move onto counting in 10's. We will first start by counting aloud and then write the number sequences. We will represent these using numerals, objects and pictorial models.

In phonics, we will learn the digraphs air as in hair, ear as in draw and ear (air) as in pear complete a recap on the sounds we know so far. We will identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.

In Science, we will recap our learning about animal groups and their diets. We will then learn about the various structures of animals and why these are important to different animals such as beak, claws, fins.
