Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 3rd February

Maths	We will be continuing our learning on time, focusing on telling the time digitally. The children will also learn how many minutes are in an hour, and in a day. To finish off the week, the children will complete their hot assessment on time, multiplication, and division. Please revise these on Google classroom.
English	The children will be finishing off planning and writing their own version of The Stone Age boy, focusing on using speech and the correct punctuation.
Science	In science the children will answer their enquiry question, using their new knowledge from the topic rocks and fossils. 'What type of rock would be best to build a house and why?' This week the children will also complete their hot assessment, which will test the children on the 3 rock types, naming a rock, its type and how it is formed, ordering the stages of how a fossil is formed and naming the 3 layers of soil. Please revise these areas on Google classroom.
Integrated Curriculum	To finish off our Stone Age topic, the children will be creating cave paintings and learning how to draw stone age animals. They will also be creating their own fossil out of clay.
