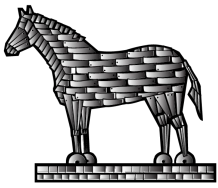


We value your continued support in working together to ensure your child makes the best progress. Therefore our next parent workshop is 'Making Maths Practical'.
