Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 3rd February

Maths	We will be carrying on our learning of fractions next week. The children will be adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominators. Then, they will be adding and subtracting with different denominators. After that, they will learn how to add and subtract mixed numbers before adding across a whole.
English	Now the children have planned for their instruction writing, they will be using everything they have learnt, including bullet points, headings, sub-headings and parenthesis to write their very own set of instructions. They will then have the chance to edit and improve their work before publishing it. We are looking forward to reading them!
Science	In science, the children will be putting their goggles on and becoming real scientists! They will be creating a reaction using their knowledge of gases. After that, they will write up their results, explaining what happened.
Integrated Curriculum	In our integrated curriculum lesson next week, the children will learn how to find volcanoes on a map. The children will also be learning about the effects of a volcanic eruption.
