Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 17th February

Maths	In maths, we will begin our new 'Multiplication and Division' topic. We will start the week by assessing the children's prior knowledge of this unit. Next, the children will learn to recognise equal and unequal groups before understanding how to make equal groups of their own. At the end of the week, we will also launch Times Table Rock Stars and encourage the children to use it at home in order to improve their knowledge of the 2 and 10 times table and division facts.
English	In English, the children will begin to plan and write their own version of the 'Jack and the Beanstalk' story. We will continue to focus on getting the children to say their sentence, write their sentence and read their sentence back (to check that it makes sense). Within their writing, they will be expected to include capital letters, full stops, adjectives and exclamation marks.
Science	In science, the children will conclude their learning about 'Plants'. This week, we will revise what a plant needs to be healthy and what a healthy plant looks like compared with an unhealthy plant. Furthermore, the children will complete a quiz to demonstrate their learning from the unit.
Integrated Curriculum	The children are very excited to welcome their parents to the fort making session on Wednesday 19th February at 7.45am. In last week's lesson, the children designed their own fort, and decided what materials they would use to create it (against an agreed success criteria). In Wednesday's session, the children will use these designs, as well as the success criteria, in order to create their fort using the materials they have brought into school. Later in the week, the children will evaluate the success of their forts by focusing on what went well and how it could be improved next time.
