Week beginning: Monday 17th February

Maths	In maths, we will be continuing our work with fractions, whilst consolidating previous learning from before the half term.
English	In English, we will be beginning our new text. We will be learning how to talk our text and then also examining the features of the explanation text
Science	In science, we will be starting our new topic of sound. We will be examining how objects make sounds and discuss using technical vocabulary, such as vibrations.
