FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 24th February

This week, in our Understanding the World lessons, we will be learning about the life cycle of a chicken. We will also visit the Grow Zone, where chicks have just hatched! Keep an eye on Seesaw for some awesome photos.

In our Phonics lessons this week we will introduce the **ow** grapheme and the sound /ow/ as heard in c**ow**, town and brown. We will continue the theme of Little Red Riding Hood, and our main focus will be on developing blending and segmenting skills. We will learn to recognise and use the HFWs **now**, **look**, **down**. Use the words at home to compose simple sentences. Can you use more than one at a time?

This week in literacy, we will continue our exploration of *The Little Red Hen*, focusing on the characters and their attitudes towards hard work, helping others, and being a good friend. Additionally, we will further develop our writing skills during Drawing Club, while immersing ourselves in the story as part of our *Talk for Writing* approach.

In PSED we will continue to discuss our value of Resilience. We will talk about what a growth mindset means and how we can practise it in class. We will focus on our finger muscles and concentration as part of our PD, so that we can improve our writing skills.

This week in Expressive Art and Design we will continue creating props using various materials, for role playing characters in narratives and stories.


Week beginning: 3rd March 2025
