Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 24th February

This week in Literacy, we will explore any new key vocabulary from our Talk For Writing story, "Rosie's Walk," to enhance our understanding of their meanings. As the story follows a route through a farm featuring a flour mill, we will seize the opportunity to learn how to measure ingredients for bread-making in the machine and discuss the changes we observe as it cooks.

This week in Phonics, we will engage with alliterative stories and rhymes, allowing us to explore the fun of sound patterns in language. We will specifically focus on emphasising the initial sounds we hear in various words, helping us to develop our phonemic awareness. As we practice, we will pay close attention to the movement of our tongues when we pronounce these sounds, enhancing our articulation skills. Through this playful approach, we aim to deepen our understanding of phonics while enjoying the rhythm and melody of language.

This week in Math, we will further investigate shapes and their various properties. Through engaging activities, we will learn to identify how shapes can be used to construct, balance, and enrich our drawings. We will also explore how different shapes interact with one another, fostering a deeper understanding of their relationships. By the end of the week, we aim to enhance our creativity and spatial awareness as we apply our knowledge of shapes in practical and artistic ways.

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will delve deeper into the diverse range of drawings we can create using continuous lines. We will experiment with various techniques to understand how a single, unbroken line can convey movement, emotion, and form. Through hands-on activities, we will encourage creativity and exploration, allowing each student to develop their unique style.

Preschool PE Days:


PE will be on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. On their PE days, students should wear their PE kit to school.

Resilience




Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Resilience** in Term 2.
