# Year 1 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 24th February

This week we will continue our topic about 'Food Glorious Food' and will learn all about what plants need to help them grow and survive. We will use this knowledge to help us to take care of our seeds that we have planted so that we can watch them grow over the next few weeks.

In our English lessons we will receive a letter with a set of instructions for planting a seed. We will read and follow these instructions and use our knowledge from the previous week to identify the different features of instructions such as title, how to and number steps. We will then use the instructions to talk the text and add our own actions to it.

In maths, we will explore our number topic focusing on addition and subtraction. We will recap our knowledge of number bonds to 20 and use this to help complete addition and subtraction sums We will then learn strategies that will help to complete addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers from a 2 digit number i.e. 16 + 12 = and 18 - 11 =

In phonics, we will learn the sounds 'long e' as in me, 'o' as in so and 'nk' as in sink We will be learning to identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.
