Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 24th February

Maths	In maths, we will continue with our 'Multiplication and Division' topic. The children will begin the week by adding equal groups using the method of repeated addition. During the lesson, the children will learn how to describe pictures using sentences and also create pictures from given sentences. Next, the children will be introduced to the multiplication symbol (x) by recognising multiplication number sentences that are equal to repeated additions. For example: 3 x 2 is equal to 2 + 2 + 2. They will also learn the meaning of, and be encouraged to use, key mathematical vocabulary, such as: 'lots of', 'times', 'multiplied by' and 'groups of'. The children will then learn about arrays, with a focus on the fact that multiplication is commutative, and children should be encouraged to identify the two multiplication sentences that can be seen in an array.
English	In English, the children will continue to plan and write the next few sections of their own version of the 'Jack and the Beanstalk' story. We will continue to focus on getting the children to say their sentence, write their sentence and read their sentence back (to check that it makes sense). Within their writing, the children will be expected to include capital letters, full stops, adjectives and exclamation marks.
Science	We will start our new science-based topic entitled 'Material World'. The children will begin by identifying the uses of everyday materials by going on a 'material hunt' around the school. They will then identify the suitability of everyday materials before being set a special challenge. The results from the challenge will enable them to understand the importance of using materials that are fit for purpose.
