Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 24th February

Maths	This week the children will learn how to compare and order non unit fractions and start to make links between fractions and scales. They will be able to count fractions on a number line, and will learn how to find fractions of amounts (practically).	
English	This week is our imitate stage of talk for writing. The children will begin to learn the 4 verses of our rainforest senses poem. We will take a walk around the school grounds, exploring what we can see, hear, smell and touch. We will then revisit alliterations, prefixes, homophones and poetry punctuation, before starting the innovate stage of writing up a poem.	
Science	We will begin by exploring forces in our everyday lives and on the school grounds. Next, the children will be inspecting magnets and learning our new vocabulary 'repel' and 'attract'. The children will be exploring which objects repel and attract, and which are non magnetic around the classroom. Throughout the week, the children will learn that a magnet has 2 poles.	
Integrated Curriculum	Continuing our topic on Global Gardens, we will explore the layers of a rainforest and the animals living in each layer. In art the children will learn about the artist Henry Rousseau and will create a mirror animal picture in his style.
