Ramadan Kareem! We wish you and your family a very blessed Ramadan. During the holy month, the school day timings will be as follows:

### FS2 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 3rd March

This week in literacy, we will continue exploring *The Little Red Hen*, focusing on innovation and understanding as we examine the characters' attitudes toward work, helping others and friendship. Alongside this, we will further develop our writing skills while engaging with the text through *Talk for Writing*.

This week Green Froggy introduces the **ee** grapheme, with the phoneme heard in the words **see**, **been**, and **feet**. Our theme will be Sleeping Beauty; a simple version of the story can be found here - <u>The Big Sleep</u>. We will focus on developing blending and segmenting skills in all of our in class activities and concentrate on HFWs: see, going, just, have. Please practise saying these words in sentences out loud, and show the children the written word in story books.

This week in maths, we will be looking at sharing amounts and how we can share amounts evenly.

For the next couple of weeks, we will be conducting various experiments in our Understanding the World lessons, starting with a lava-making experiment. The ingredients for the experiment can be found <u>here</u>, if you would like to try it at home. If you do, please send us pictures!

In Expressive Art and Design this week we will be introducing weaving and we will be weaving a picnic blanket and a basket for the Little Red Hen

In PSED we will continue to focus on the value of Resilience. We are going to discuss how we can show resilience during the holy month of Ramadan, as well as how we can show kindness and tolerance towards each other in this time. We will be making beautiful Ramadan Kareem cards for our family and friends as part of our PD this week, to further develop our fine motor skills.


