Ramadan Kareem! We wish you and your family a very blessed Ramadan. During the holy month, the school day timings will be as follows:

From Monday to Thursday lessons will begin promptly at 9.00am and end at 2:00pm. On Friday lessons will begin promptly 9:00 am until 12:00 pm

Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 3rd March

Maths	In maths, we will continue with our 'Multiplication and Division' topic. The children
	will begin the week by making equal groups to help develop their understanding of division. First, we will focus on the method of 'grouping'. This will involve the children using practical equipment to answer questions, such as: 'Take 15 cubes. Put them into groups of 3. How many groups are there?' Next, the children will use the method of 'sharing' in order to divide numbers. For example, if the question is: 15 ÷ 5, then the children will draw 5 circles (groups) and share 15 blocks out equally between the circles (groups). The children will learn that the answer is 3 because there are 3 blocks in each group. Following this, the children will practise their 2 times tables facts before using and applying this knowledge to a range of reasoning and problem-solving tasks. Finally, the children will divide by 2 using the methods of sharing and grouping.
English	In English, the children will continue to plan and write the resolution and ending of their own version of the 'Jack and the Beanstalk' story. We will continue to focus on getting the children to say their sentence, write their sentence and read their sentence back (to check that it makes sense). Within their writing, the children will be expected to include capital letters, full stops, adjectives and exclamation marks. The children will finish the week by editing their work in groups of three using purple pen.
Science	In science, we will continue with our science-based topic entitled 'Material World'. The children will begin the week by comparing the suitability of everyday materials by generating adjectives to describe the properties of different materials. Following this, they will use and apply the knowledge they have learnt within discussions about the different uses of materials. For example: Why is a window made of glass? Finally, the children will identify and classify the uses of different materials.


