Dear Parents,

Ramadan Kareem! We wish you and your family a very blessed Ramadan. During the holy month, the school day timings will be as follows:

From **Monday to Thursday** lessons will begin promptly at **9.00am and end at 2:00pm**.

On **Friday** lessons will begin promptly **9:00 am until 12:00 pm**

The school gates will open at 8.50am each day. Children will go straight to their classrooms where their teachers will be there to welcome them. The playground will not be in use or supervised between 8.50 am and 9 am.



During the holy month, teachers will fully support any child who decides to fast. However, we would recommend that they bring in a small bottle of water and a small snack in case they need to break their fast. Please be reminded that the canteen will not be selling food and drink for students in the primary department during this time.

Please note, as the collection time for all students is 2 pm, our extra curricular activities provision will be suspended during this time. The ECA programme will resume in Term 3.

Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 3rd March

Maths	The children will be continuing to learn about fractions. Firstly, learning how to find equivalent fractions on a number line, and then understanding them on a bar model. We will then be finding tenths, and learning how to count in tenths. To finish the week we will begin to add fractions with the same denominator.
English	After learning our poetry text 'Rainforests' we will start to 'Innovate' our text, changing it to be about an ocean. This week, the children will plan and write up all 4 verses, using their own ideas.
Science	We will be exploring magnets and learning how forces need contact between 2 objects, but that magnets can act at a distance. We will then complete an investigation to group materials whether they are attracted to a magnet or not. The children will learn the skills of predicting, comparing and grouping.
Integrated Curriculum	Continuing on our rainforest topic, the children will compare a rainforest and desert, focusing on their features and the animals who live there. In art, we will learn about Henry Rousseau and explore his artwork 'fantasy jungle'.

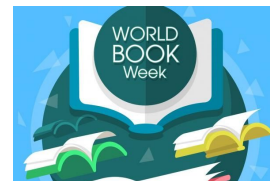
