### Dear Parents,

Ramadan Kareem! We wish you and your family a very blessed Ramadan. During the holy month, the school day timings will be as follows:

From **Monday to Thursday** lessons will begin promptly at **9.00am and end at 2:00pm**. On **Friday** lessons will begin promptly **9:00 am until 12:00 pm** 

The school gates will open at 8.50am each day. Children will go straight to their classrooms where their teachers will be there to welcome them. The playground will not be in use or supervised between 8.50 am and 9 am.



During the holy month, teachers will fully support any child who decides to fast. However, we would recommend that they bring in a small bottle of water and a small snack in case they need to break their fast. Please be reminded that the canteen will not be selling food and drink for students in the primary department during this time.

Please note, as the collection time for all students is 2 pm, our extra curricular activities provision will be suspended during this time. The ECA programme will resume in Term 3.

## Year 4 learning:

### Week beginning: Monday 3rd March

Maths	In Maths, Year 4 will be continuing to work on their understanding of fractions and decimals and their relationship with each other. Following this, they will move on to exploring units of measure, more specifically converting between them.
English	In English, Year 4 will be working through two more of the features of an explanation text. They will be focussing on diagrams and how they are used in this style of text, as well as subordinate clauses and conjunctions.
Science	In Science, we will be exploring and investigating pitch. The children will be explaining how to change the pitch of sounds and observing how this may look in sound waves.
Integrated Curriculum	In our Topic learning, Year 4 will be analysing Morse code as a form of communication. They will be then be using what they have learnt to decode and code messages.
