Dear Parents,

Ramadan Kareem! We wish you and your family a very blessed Ramadan. During the holy month, the school day timings will be as follows:

From **Monday to Thursday** lessons will begin promptly at **9.00am and end at 2:00pm.**

On **Friday** lessons will begin promptly **9:00 am until 12:00 pm**

The school gates will open at 8.50am each day. Children will go straight to their classrooms where their teachers will be there to welcome them. The playground will not be in use or supervised between 8.50 am and 9 am.



During the holy month, teachers will fully support any child who decides to fast. However, we would recommend that they bring in a small bottle of water and a small snack in case they need to break their fast. Please be reminded that the canteen will not be selling food and drink for students in the primary department during this time.

Please note, as the collection time for all students is 2 pm, our extra curricular activities provision will be suspended during this time. The ECA programme will resume in Term 3.

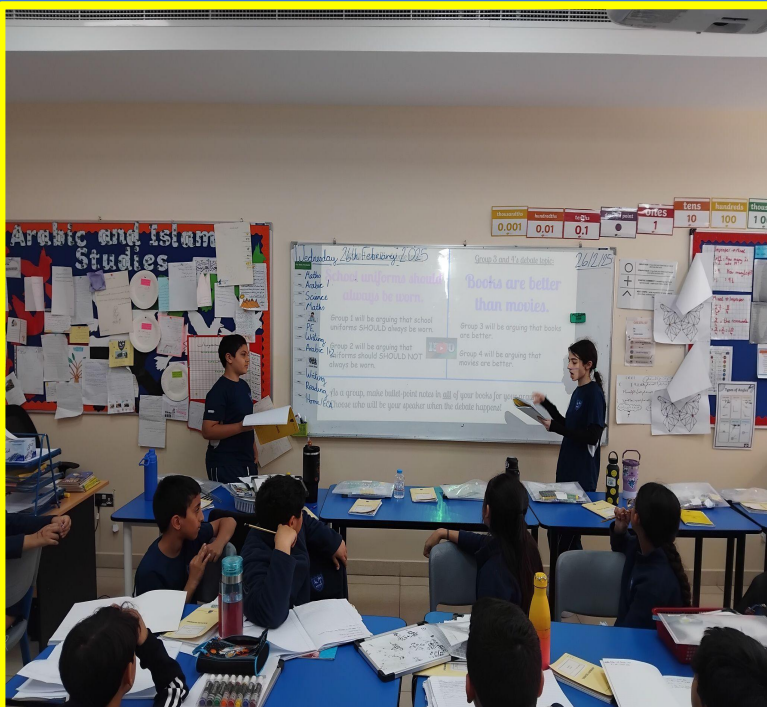


Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Resilience** in Term 2.
