Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 10th March

This week in Math, we will focus on following a simple route. As we do this, we will also incorporate the positional language we've been getting familiar with. This language is derived from the Talk for Writing story, "Rosie's Walk." We aim to deepen our understanding of both the route and the language. This activity will help us connect our math skills with the storytelling elements we've explored.

This week in Phonics, we will continue to concentrate on voice sounds. We will work on adding sound effects to a song using our voices. Additionally, we will learn to discuss the various sounds we can produce. This activity will help us explore the capabilities of our voices and allow us to understand the versatility of our voices.

This week in Literacy, we will begin retelling the first part of the story by using our story map, which includes pictures to guide us. As we share our retellings, we will pay special attention to how we introduce our story to the audience. This will help us engage listeners right from the start and set the tone for our narrative. We will practice using expressive language and clear descriptions to make our introductions captivating. By the end of the week, we hope to improve our storytelling skills and build confidence in presenting our stories.

This week in Understanding the World, we will continue our exploration of different materials and their unique properties by engaging in hands-on activities where we will investigate various objects to see which ones float and which ones sink. As we conduct these experiments, we will discuss any changes that we observe in the appearance of the objects during the process. This activity will not only enhance our understanding of materials but also promote critical thinking and observation skills.

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will focus on encouraging children to respond to what they have heard, allowing them to express their thoughts and feelings creatively. We will engage in various active listening activities designed to enhance their listening skills and comprehension. Through these activities, children will learn to articulate their reactions and emotions in response to different sounds and stories. We will also provide opportunities for them to create art that reflects their feelings and interpretations of what they have experienced.

Preschool PE Days:

PE will be on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. On their PE days, students should wear their PE kit to school.
