### Dear Parents,

As part of the UAE's Year of Community initiative, and during the Holy month of Ramadan, we have introduced Service Learning Fridays. ### Year 1 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 10th March

This week in our English lessons we will be continuing our work on instructions. We will begin the week by following practical instructions on washing our hands. Then we will sequence the events in the correct order and write full sentences to complete the instructions. We will use our work from the previous week to ensure that we have included imperative verbs (bossy words) and time connectives.

In maths we will begin our topic on measurement. We will start the week by learning and using the language associated with length and height such as short, shorter, long, longer, shorter than, longer than. We will then use non - standard units to measure length and height such as cubes, hands and feet.

In phonics, we will revise the split digraph sounds 'a\_e', 'e\_e', 'i\_e' as well as learning the soft 'c' sound such as race. We will be learning to identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.

In topic we shall continue to look at different types of food and where the food comes from. We will also look at the work of the artist Hundertwasser. We will focus on using some of the techniques he used to begin our own artwork such as colours and shapes.
