Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 10th March

Maths	Continuing our fractions topic, we will learn how to subtract fractions, to find unit and non unit fractions of an amount of objects and how to partition a whole into fractions.
English	Using what we have learnt so far about poetry, we are going to write our own poem about a setting of our choice, following the structure of the 'Rainforest' poem we have been learning. Firstly gathering ideas and using a thesaurus to collect vocabulary, then planning and writing 4 verses.
Science	Continuing on our topic on magnets and forces, we will be exploring which materials are magnetic and which are not, learning that not all metals are magnetic.
Integrated Curriculum	This week the children will learn about compasses, the 4 points and how to use one to navigate. The children will be practically directing their friends around the playground. In art, we will be exploring abstract art, through drawing leaves, using pastels.
