## Year 1 learning:

#### Week beginning: 7th & 14th April 2025

This term, in English, we will be looking at poetry. We will start our learning by recapping our knowledge of poetry particularly rhyming words. We will then receive a letter from the park police with clues to introduced our text "A shark in the Park". The children will then add actions to the text and begin to use these to help them remember this.

In maths, we will continue our topic on measurement. We will begin the week investigating mass and weight and learning the vocabulary related to this topic such as heavier, lighter. We will then use objects to be able to record measurement such as cubes and then learn to use weights to accurately measure and then compare the weight of objects. We will end the week by looking at capacity and using language such as full and empty.

During our Phonic lessons we will be revising the digraphs 'ee' (as in see), 'ea' (as in leaf) as well as learning about the 'soft g' (as in age and gem). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly.

In Science we will begin to explore materials and objects and investigate which ones sink and float. We will make predictions and observations during our experiment. In our topic lessons we will be looking at primary and secondary colours and how we can mix the primary colours to make a range of colours and various shades.
