Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 7th April and Monday 14th April

Maths	The children will begin their unit on Mass and Capacity, learning how to use scales, measuring mass in grams and KG. We will also be exploring how to measure equivalent masses (kg and g). Throughout the first 2 weeks we will be practising our 3 and 4 times table. Please practise these at home.
English	Our next text will be 'Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. The children will be learning our Talk for Writing text in the first few weeks. To introduce the children to the Iron Man we will be creating a junk modelling Iron man out of recycling and reading the story. In week 2 we will be introducing fronted adverbials, time conjunctions and cause conjunctions. The children will be exploring scene 1 through drama and will be focusing on Hogarth's feelings.
Science	In science our next topic will be 'Light'. The children will be learning to recognise the different types of light sources and investigating which surfaces reflect light. They will be completing an investigation, where they will learn how to predict first and then create a conclusion from the results.
Integrated Curriculum	Our next topic is called 'Lighting up the world'. We will begin my learning who created the light bulb and the history of the light bulb. In art the children will be exploring what the primary colours are and using these in their art work.
