| Maths | As we come back to school, the children will be revising their understanding of addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. Then, the children will be learning to find the perimeter of rectangles and rectangular shapes. |
| English | As we start our new topic in Writing, the children will be learning to use prefixes and suffixes in their writing. Then, they will be planning and writing a non-chronological report. |
| Science | The children will be delving straight into science experiments when they come back to school. They will be participating in an experiment where they have to record their reaction time. Then they will be visiting different classes in KS2 to measure the height of children and will be recording this and finding the average for each year group. This will help the children to understand what happens to their height as they get older. |
| Integrated Curriculum | In topic, we will be starting our new learning of 'A Trip to the Far East'. For this, the children will learn to identify countries of the Far East on a map before learning to compare and contrast the different cultures in the Far East. |
