Maths	This week in Maths, we will be reviewing our unit on Algebra. We will then begin our unit on Ratio, exploring its relationship with fractions before learning how to calculate ratios.
English	Writing - For our first Thursday back, we will be completing a creative writing piece of work! For our second week back, we will be completing the HOOK activity for our new unit of work with The Malamander novel, using character descriptions to create a picture, unpicking evidence from Chapter 2 and learning how to use evidence to support a statement.
Science	This week in Science we will be reviewing our unit of electricity, building a complete understanding of what we have learnt. In the lab, students will be planning their alarm systems and investigating how they work.
Integrated Curriculum	In IC, we will be continuing to explore our topic of Formula Ethara, using teamwork and creativity to build our cars.
