FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 21st April

Linking to our topic 'Long, long ago...' we will explore the rich heritage of the United Arab Emirates through story-telling in our Understanding the World lessons.

This week in Expressive Art This and Design we will be discussing performances and what this means. We will be reflecting on the Winter concert and how the children felt when they were on stage.

This week in maths we will be comparing different quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognise when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as the other quantity.

During PSED lessons, we will focus on what it means to be honest. We will continue to focus on combining different movements during our swimming lessons as well as while during our EAD lessons when we start to prepare for our end of year performance.

This week in Literacy, we're beginning our exciting new theme: *Long, Long Ago!* We'll be diving into the classic tale *Jack and the Beanstalk* through *Talk for Writing*, helping children learn the story with actions and storytelling. In *Drawing Club*, we'll use our imaginations to bring the story to life through creative drawings and mark-making.

This week in Phonics we will introduce the grapheme **or** and continue the theme of Hansel and Gretel. We will focus on developing blending and segmenting skills during class activities. Our High Frequency Words will be: **it's, do, so.**
