Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 21st April

	,
Maths	In maths, we will carry on with our 'Fractions' unit of work. The children will learn how to find half of numbers and sets of objects. Following this, they will focus on finding a quarter of shapes and pictures before applying their knowledge to finding a quarter of numbers and sets of objects. Finally, the children will learn how to recognise a third of shapes and pictures. In a few week's time, the children will be learning how to tell the time on an analogue clock. To prepare them for this, it would be great if you could practise telling the time on an analogue clock with your child at home.
English	In English, we will be continuing with our 'wishing tale' unit. Throughout the week, the children will continue to practise talking the 'Bob's Best Ever Friend' text. Following this, they will develop their understanding of how to use punctuation correctly with a focus on capital letters, full stops, questions marks and exclamation marks. The children will then recap when and how to use conjunctions, such as 'and', 'but' and 'so' accurately. To finish the week, the children will work in small groups to identify errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation with Miss Oh No's version of the model text.
Science	In science, we will be using our 'working scientifically' skills as the children are presented with the 'Humpty Dumpty Challenge'. Can they choose the appropriate materials and work together in their groups to protect Humpty Dumpty when he has his 'great fall'?
Integrated Curriculum	In Integrated Curriculum, we will continue with our topic, 'Up, Up and Away'. The children will learn all about logos before working in their 'topic teams' to design their own logo.
