Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 21st April

Maths	In Year 4, we will be recapping division facts for the 2, 4, and 8 times tables. The children will also be starting to use the short-division method and applying the facts to this.
English	Next week, the children will be exploring direct speech in their English. They will be learning about the different rules for using direct speech in a narrative, as well as the different pieces of punctuation to make it correct. Also, we will be researching synonyms for said to improve our writing.
Science	In Year 4, we will be continuing to investigate electricity. They will be developing their understanding on insulators and conductors, whilst also exploring complete and incomplete circuits.
Integrated Curriculum	Next week, the children will be learning about the different, specific continents. They will be researching and collecting facts about the continents and how they are different.
