Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th April

Maths	In maths, we will carry on with our 'Fractions' unit of work. To start the week, the children will learn how to find a third of numbers and sets of objects. Following this, they will use a fraction of an amount to find the whole. For example: ½ of = 5. Next, the children will learn about unit fractions, which is any fraction where the numerator is 1. For example: ½, $\frac{1}{3}$ or $\frac{1}{3}$. Following this, the children will begin to learn about non-unit fractions, which are fractions when the numerator is greater than 1. For example: $\frac{2}{3}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$.
English	In English, we will be continuing with our 'wishing tale' unit. Throughout the week, the children will practise talking the 'Bob's Best Ever Friend' text. Following this, the children will then develop their sentence writing skills by using expanded noun phrases to describe different pictures from 'Bob's Best Ever Friend'. The children will then learn when and how to use conjunctions, such as 'and', 'but' and 'so'. To finish the week, the children will write dictated sentences from the story.
Science	In science, we will be using our 'working scientifically' skills in order to plan a fair test. The children will also predict which surface would be the most suitable to use as the runway for Humpty Dumpty's plane.
Integrated Curriculum	As part of our 'Up, Up and Away' topic, the children will practise making different types of paper aeroplanes and will test them to find out which one can fly the furthest. In their topic groups, the children will then use their imagination and collaboration skills to design their very own aeroplanes.
