Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th April

Maths	In maths we will be starting our multiplication and division unit, revisiting how to multiply a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number (x3, x4) and solving problems using this method. We will then revisit how to divide a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number using flexible partitioning.	
English	In english we will be continuing to write our innovation story based on The Iron Man text. The children will learn how to plan paragraph 3 and 4, and then will write it up using their own collected vocabulary. We will be encouraging the children to use time and cause conjunctions in their sentences.	
Science	The children will be exploring how to use a mirror to reflect light by playing mirror games. They will learn and be able to explain how a mirror works. After this, we will be focusing on the sun as a source of light and how it can be dangerous. The children will learn how we can protect our skin and eyes from the sun, and will create a sun safety leaflet or poster.	
Integrated Curriculum	Continuing on our topic on light, the children will be learning about the northern lights and lighthouses. In art, we will be exploring using chalk on black paper to create a northern lights picture.
