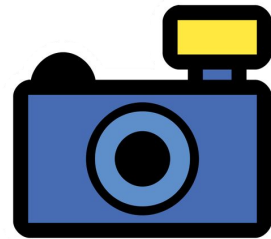

| Maths | In maths, Year 4 will be continuing to explore the short method of division. They will be practising using this method to divide by 3, 6 and 9, following on from their learning this week of 2, 4 and 8. |
| English | In English, Year 4 will be recapping the use of fronted adverbials and expanded noun phrases. They will also be diving deeper into our model text, creating character profiles for Phileas Fogg and Passepartout, our main characters. |
| Science | In science, Year 4 will be further developing their understanding of how complete and incomplete circuits work. They will be looking closer in detail at switches and how they affect the flow of electricity in circuits. |
| Integrated Curriculum | In Topic, Year 4 will be focussing their learning around one of the seven world continents. They will be researching and learning about animals that live on the continents as well as important landmarks. |
