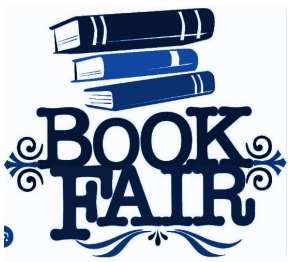
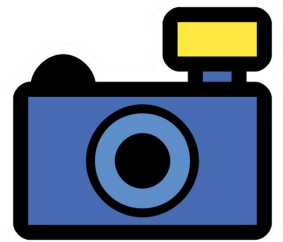

Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 28th April

Maths	Next week, Year 5 will be revising their understanding of multiplying and dividing 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, factors and multiples and squared numbers.
English	In writing, the children will be continuing their learning of non-chronological reports. They will be analysing a text, learning to build cohesion in sentences using a range of devices and recapping their understanding of relative clauses.
Science	As the children continue their science topic, they will be learning about animal gestation periods and plotting these onto a graph. They will also be learning about the human skeleton and why bones are important.
Integrated Curriculum	Last week, the children completed a carousel activity where they found out lots of facts about countries in the Far East. This week, they will be using that information to create a fact-file. Then, they will be learning more about the Great Wall of China.

Respect



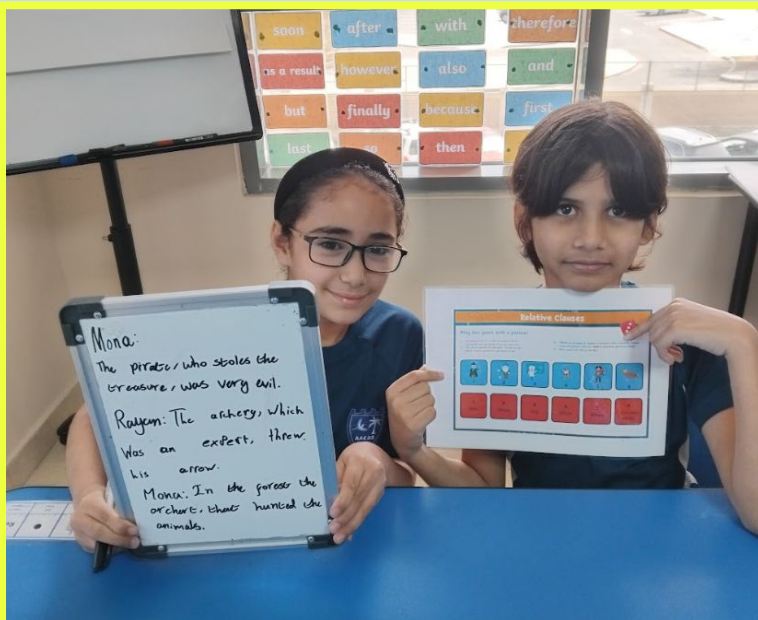
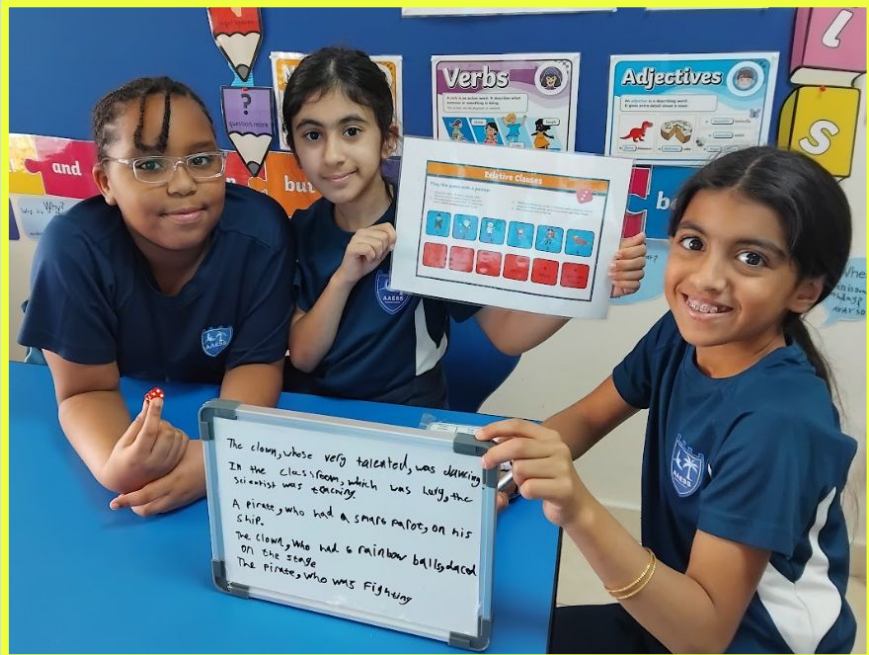
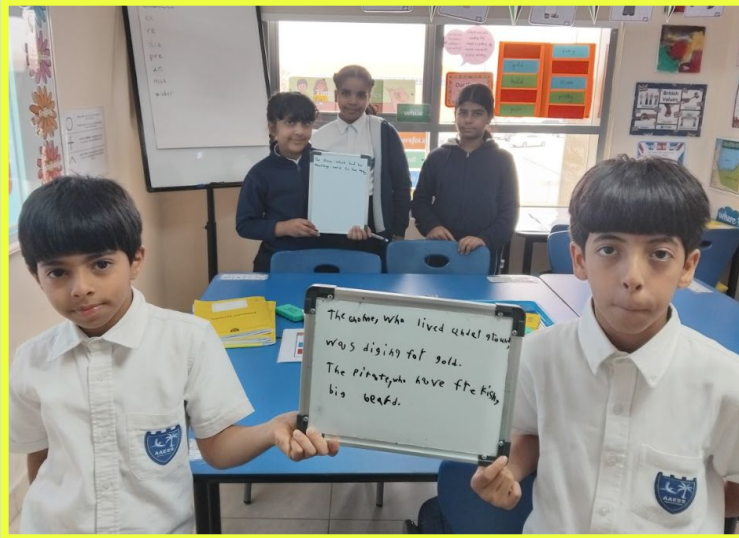
Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Respect** in Term 3.
