## Year 3 learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 5th May

Maths	This week we will continue with multiplication and division and be focusing on the link between the two. We will then be looking at the link between multiplication and scaling. Finally towards the end of the week, we will be answering problem solving questions linked to multiplication.
English	This week the children will be planning their own story based on 'The Iron Man' then they will write it up as their end of unit hot task assessment. The children will learn how to change parts of a story and to independently turn this plan into a story, made up of paragraphs.
Science	Continuing our topic on 'light' the children will be learning the properties of light (reflections, shadows, colours) and exploring how shadows are formed. We will be teaching the children some new vocabulary (transparent, translucent and opaque) and they will begin an investigation on shadows.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic the children will be learning about time zones around the world. In Art, the children will be exploring the work of two great historic artists Mondrian and Kandinsky and creating their own art in these styles.


