Week beginning: Monday 5th May

Maths	In Maths next week, Year 4 will be beginning their learning of time. They will be looking at telling and converting time, in relation to seconds minutes and hours as well as days, weeks, months and years.
English	In English next week, Year 4 will be understanding how to structure a paragraph. They will also be developing their understanding of including subordinate clauses in their writing and using past tense verbs correctly.
Science	In Science next week, Year 4 will be recapping their knowledge of circuits, specifically switches. They will be investigating what objects and materials make good switches.
Integrated Curriculum	In Topic next week, Year 4 will be continuing their learning of their chosen continent. They will be developing their knowledge of this by researching into different festivals and geographical features, such as mountains and rivers.


