Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 12th May:

This week in Math, we will be delving into sequencing cards that depict the steps of getting dressed after swimming. We'll start by examining the pictures and sharing our observations with one another, followed by arranging the cards in the order we think is correct. To add some excitement, we'll split into teams and engage in a timed challenge to see which team can complete the sequence correctly first. May the best team triumph!

This week in Drawing Club, we will be designing our own houses based on the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. In addition to our artwork, we will create a small garden with soil and a bean seed, with hopes of growing it as tall as the beanstalk in the tale. As we work, we will let our imaginations run wild and discuss the possibilities of what could happen as our plants reach new heights. We're excited to see where our creativity takes us!

This week in Literacy, we will be filling a box or bag with props related to the story of Jack and the Beanstalk, such as a bean, a gold coin, and a cow figure. As we take a look at each item one by one, we will have the opportunity to retell or act out the story using these props, which will help reinforce sequencing and vocabulary through hands-on play. Additionally, we will encourage each other to create our versions of the story, such as "My beanstalk went to space". Finally, we will act out their unique stories together as a group!

This week in Understanding the World, we will each share a baby photo alongside a current photo of ourselves, discussing how we have changed and introducing photos of our parents when they were young. We will encourage each other to think about our own life stories and family dynamics. To spark conversation, we will share simple questions like, "Who takes care of you at home?" and "What activities do you enjoy with your family?" We will also use a mirror to help with self-recognition and talk about how we all grow and change, while examining the pictures the children have brought in to discuss shared features and family similarities.

This week in phonics, we will continue practicing blending and segmenting simple words featuring our favourite monsters. We will also relate these words to real-life examples and start copying some of the letters from them. This will enhance our understanding and application of phonics skills.
