Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 12th May

Maths	Continuing our multiplication unit, the children will be using < > = symbols to compare multiplication calculations. The children will be making links between different times tables (4s and 8s then 3s and 6s) as well as making connections between multiplication and division. They will also be focusing on how to solve problems and how to reason their answers. The end of the week will be used to	
	revise multiplication, division, mass and capacity before the hot assessment.	
English	The children will be using their plan to continue to write up their hot assessment story, based around our class text 'The Iron Man'. There will be an opportunity for the children to self assess against the success criteria, and time to edit and improve. Towards the end of the week we will be introducing our new text 'The Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo.	
Science	To conclude our topic on 'Light' the children will learn how light travel into our eyes. The children will then complete a hot assessment on some of the things we have learnt.	
Integrated Curriculum	The children will understand why lighthouses were invented and the different parts to a lighthouse. In art, the children will get to make their own lantern to take home.
