Preschool learning:

Week beginning: Monday 19th May

This week in Math, we will begin to tackle real-world problems using numbers up to 5 and explore the value of 1 by finding toys or items in the classroom. We'll go on a treasure hunt for hidden number 1 cards and match them with one object, while also representing the number using our own unique marks or symbols. To reinforce our learning, we'll practice forming the number 1 with creative materials like paint, sand, and play-dough while enjoying a fun number song!

This week in Drawing Club, we will read the story, "One Camel Called Doug" and focus on the vocabulary words camel's hump, silly, and sleepy. We will introduce each word with its meaning and an action to join in on, repeating them throughout the week to reinforce our learning. By the end of the week, we will confidently say the words, understand their meaning, and perform the actions while enjoying creating wonderful drawings that incorporate our vocabulary.

This week in Literacy, we will revisit the 5 key concepts of print, focusing on how print has meaning and can serve different purposes. We will explore familiar labels and logos, discussing how print informs our daily lives and highlighting examples in different languages, including Arabic. To reinforce our learning, we will create a "Print in My World" collage using our own labels or magazine cutouts and share the significance of our choices.

This week in Expressive Art and Design, we will freely explore different materials to develop our ideas about how to use them and what we can create. We will join various materials, experiment with different textures, and select activities and resources, seeking help when needed, to achieve our chosen goals or those suggested to us. Our focus will be on using a range of materials to create our own props for the end-of-year performance!

This week in Understanding the World, we will explore toys in the UAE, comparing traditional toys that our parents or grandparents played with to the modern toys we enjoy today. We will begin by sharing our favourite toys from home and discussing how modern toys can light up, make sounds, or move. Then, we will look at traditional Emirati games and handmade toys, highlighting how families in the past used available materials to create fun and engaging play experiences

We have thoroughly enjoyed exploring all the fantastic family photos that have been shared and guessing who each child's mummy or daddy is in the pictures. Now it's your turn! We have sent an email with all the Preschool teachers photos of when they were young. Can you figure out which teachers are in the Preschool photos? Take a look and let us know your guesses!
