Dear Parents,

This week, you will receive information about our Term 3 class teacher and parent meetings which are scheduled to be held **Monday 2nd June and Tuesday 3rd June.** The meetings will give you an opportunity to discuss the developments regarding your child's attainment and progress during this year.





With the temperatures continuing to rise, please be reminded that your child will need to wear their hat to play outdoors with their friends. Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 19th May

In maths we will revisit our place value topic and we will start the week by identifying and counting, forward and backs, numbers to 100. We will then use this knowledge to partition numbers and understand how many tens and ones make up each number. We will end the week making groups of tens.

During our English lessons, we will start our new text 'The journey'. We will begin the week by discussing the word journey and making links to our knowledge of this in our everyday life. We will then make predictions about the story based on the image on the front cover and explain our ideas about what is behind the red door.

In our Phonic lessons we will be learning consonant blends 'fl' (as in flood), 'gl' (as in glue), 'pl' (as in play) and 'sl' (as in slow). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly. We will practise reading real words and pseudo alien words.

For science, we will work scientifically by completing the *Walking water* experiment. We will continue to ask questions and explore different ways they can be answered.

Reading for Pleasure




Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.


Reading regularly in Arabic doesn't just help you get better at the language; it helps you shine in all your subjects too!

Each term, we'll share a list of exciting Arabic books and awesome authors for you to explore.


