Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 19th May

Maths	In Maths, the children will be consolidating their learning of the term. They will then be recapping equivalent fractions as well as fractions of an amount.
English	In English, Year 4 will be planning and writing their own narrative based upon a journey. There will be a focus on ensuring the children are including all of the features that they have learnt about this term so far.
Science	In Science, Year 4 will be experimenting with water resistance and gravity. They will be designing and creating their own boat, to investigate how best something will float.
Integrated Curriculum	In Topic, Year 4 will be continuing their learning about their chosen continent. Specifically, they will be creating a leaflet about their chosen continent and all they have learnt so far.


Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.


Reading regularly in Arabic doesn't just help you get better at the language; it helps you shine in all your subjects too!
