Reading for Pleasure

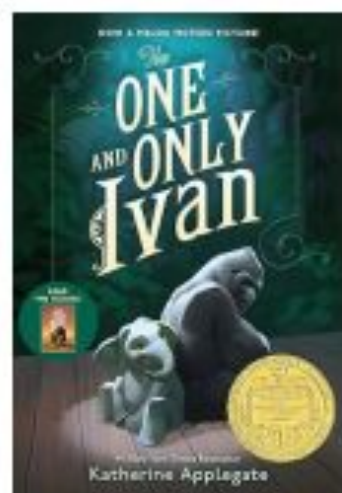

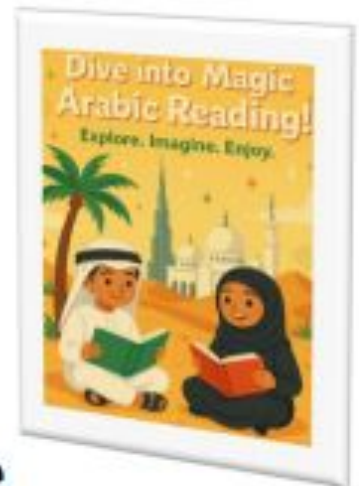

Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Respect** in Term 3.

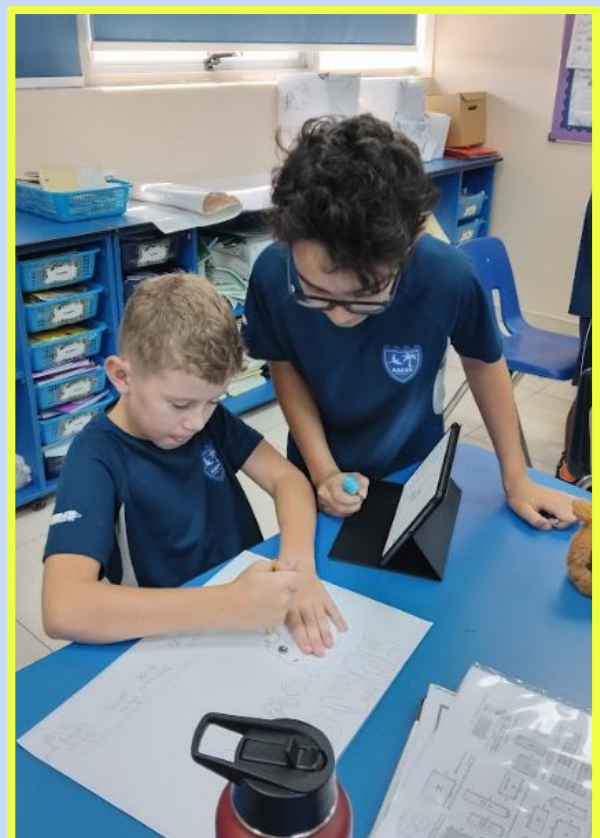
Our expectations are that students will:

- Speak appropriately when communicating with others

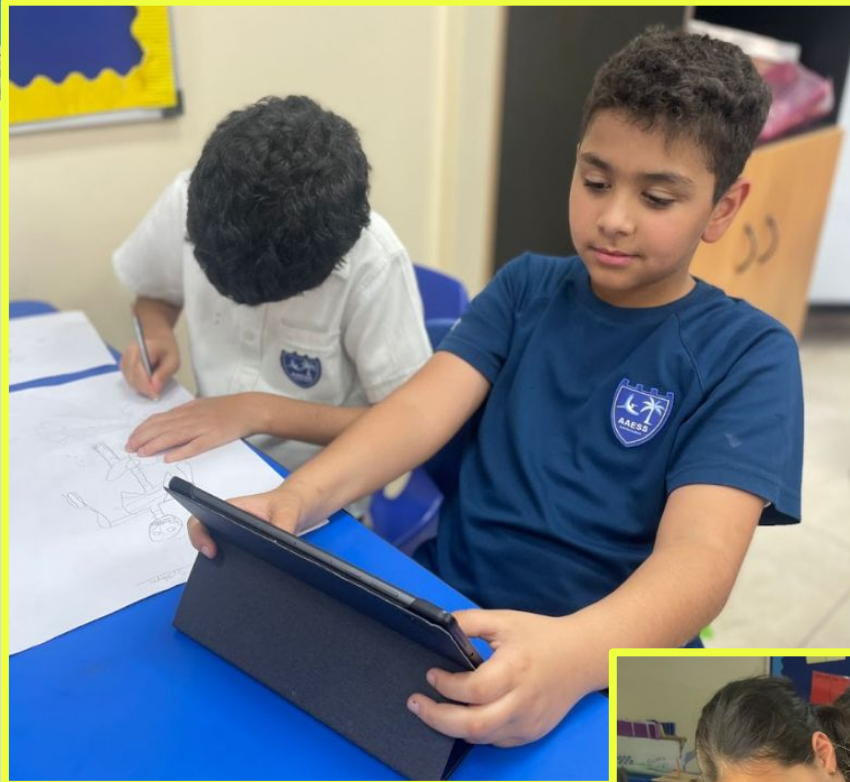
