Preschool learning:

#### Week beginning: Monday 26th May

This week in math, we will concentrate on the number 2. We will engage in activities that reinforce our understanding of the number that represents two items, practice matching it to the appropriate quantity, and explore various methods to represent the number 2 through our own marks or symbols. Furthermore, we will foster discussions about mathematical concepts throughout the day, promoting critical thinking and encouraging observations of differences in quantities both indoors and outdoors.

This week in literacy, we will deepen our understanding of logos, which will support our recognition that print conveys meaning. We will reflect on some of our favourite places we have visited and actively search for their associated logos. This engaging activity will enhance our ability to connect symbols and text to real-life experiences. We look forward to exploring how these visual representations communicate information in our everyday lives!

This week in Drawing Club, we will be reading the story of "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" to inspire our creativity. We will focus on drawing the main character while exploring key vocabulary words such as "butterfly," "caterpillar," and "sun." This activity will help enhance our language skills and deepen our understanding of the story's themes. We are excited to see how we each interpret the characters and concepts through our artwork!

This week in Understanding the World, we will explore the concept of different countries and share our diverse experiences or photographs. We will gather in a circle to discuss where we or our families are from, prompting questions such as, "What countries do you know?" and "Has anyone visited another country?" To enhance our learning, we will introduce a world map, where we will have the opportunity to place a picture of ourselves, fostering a sense of connection to the global community.

This week in phonics, we will focus on helping each other segment the sounds in simple three-letter CVC words using three engaging actions to assist us in recognising the three individual sounds we need to listen for before pronouncing the words. This playful approach will enhance our phonemic awareness and strengthen our ability to identify sounds in spoken language.

Preschool PE Days:
