Dear Parents,

Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 26th May

Maths	The children will begin a new unit, 'Position and Direction'. They will start by describing positions of objects using mathematical language, such as 'left', 'right', 'below', 'above' and 'between' before progressing onto using the vocabulary 'forwards' and 'backwards' to describe their partner's movements.
English	In English, the children will publish their versions of 'Bob's Best Ever Friend' using their neatest handwriting. At the end of the week, the children will then share their stories with another class in Year 2.
Science	In science, the children will begin a unit that is linked to our new 'Healthy Me' topic. This week, we will be investigating the effects of exercise on the human body.
Integrated Curriculum	To conclude our 'Up, Up and Away' topic, the winners from each class will compete in the auditorium to find out whose plane travels the furthest. Which group will be crowned the overall Year 2 winners?
	In addition, to launch our new 'Healthy Me' topic, the children will be going on a school trip to Trampo. More details about the trip can be found in the letter that was sent home last week.

Reading for Pleasure



Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.



Reading regularly in Arabic doesn't just help you get better at the language; it helps you shine in all your subjects too!


