| Maths | We will be continuing our Geometry topic and learning about horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines in a range of contexts. The children will be exploring 2D shapes and their properties and then recognising and naming 3D shapes in different orientations. |
| English | To start the week we will be creating a narrative toolbox of all the things that make a story excellent. Then we will begin to innovate our class text 'Egyptian Cinderella' changing the setting/characters. |
| Science | In science we will be focusing on different metals and which are magnetic and which are not. The children will be practically sorting metals into venn circles to show which attract to a magnet and which do not. |
| Integrated Curriculum | The children will be learning about the 7 wonders of the ancient world and how Egyptians rely and have relied in the past on the River Nile. In art, we will be beginning to create an Egyptian collar necklace. |

Reading for Pleasure

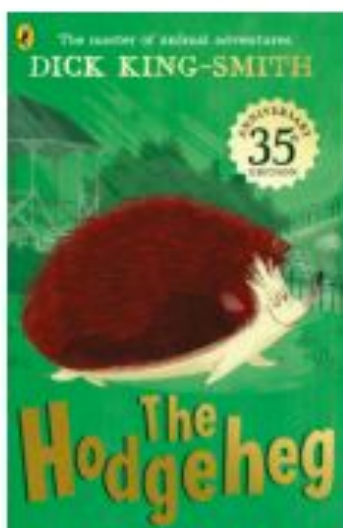
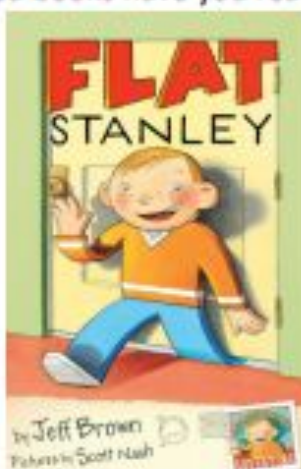
