Science	Next week, the children will be starting their learning on life cycles. They will first be introduced to life cycles and will look at simple and complex types. Then, they will be learning about the life cycle of a bird.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will be learning about the division of the earth and then learning to understand longitude and latitude.

Reading for Pleasure

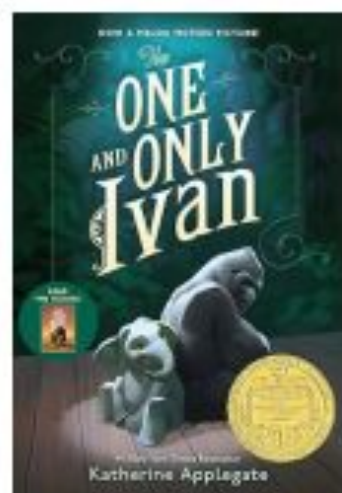

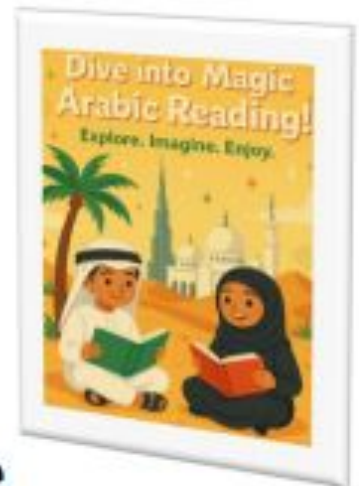

Empathy

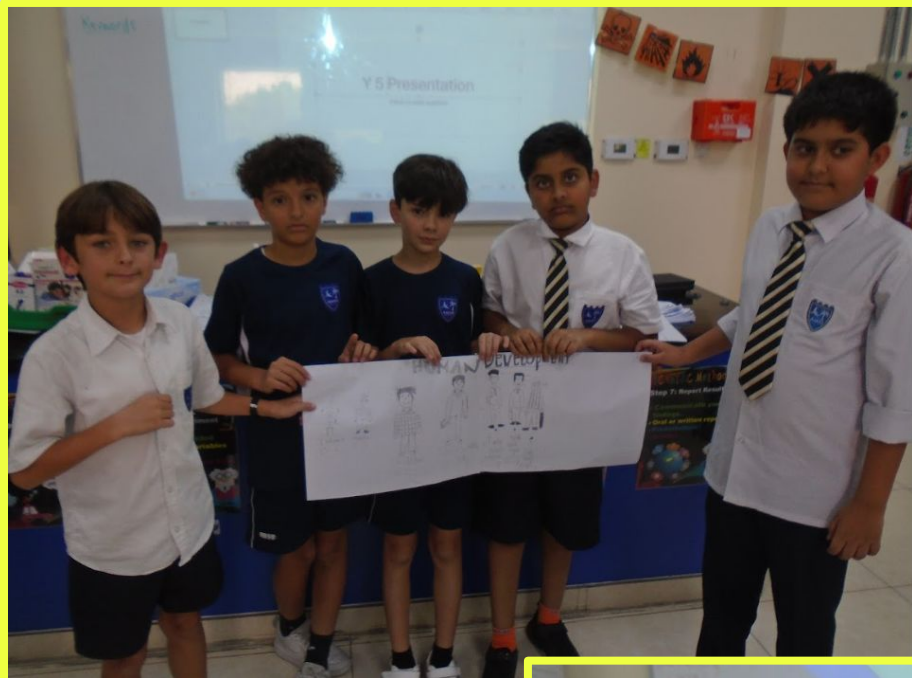


Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, we will focus on the value of **Empathy** in Term 3.

Our expectations are that students will:

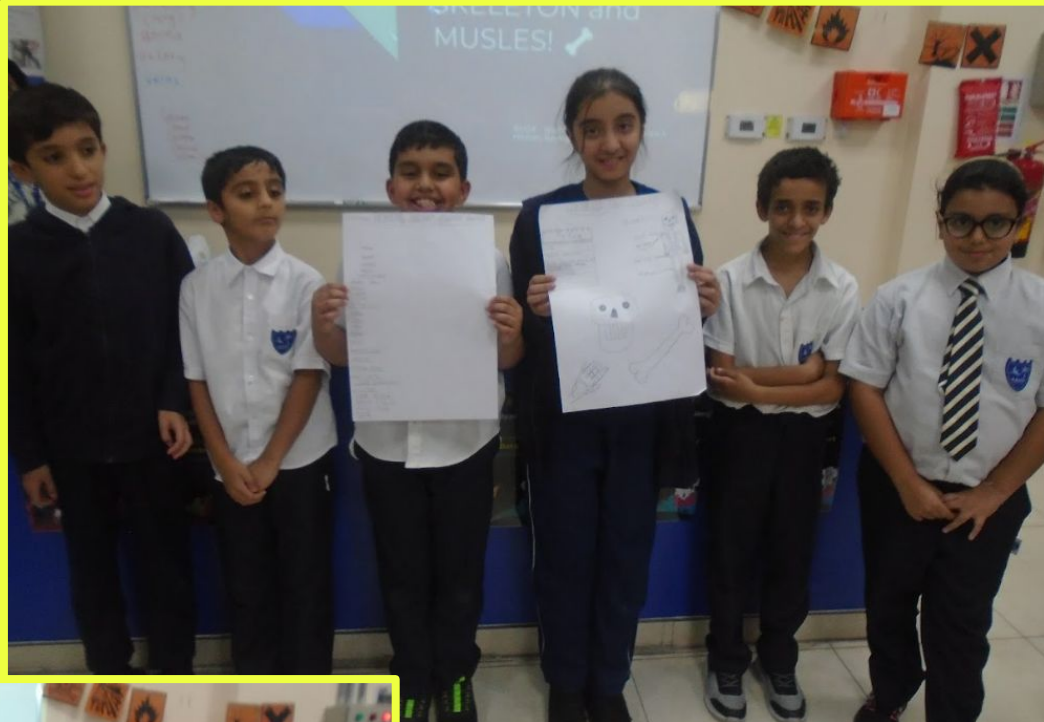
- Be mindful towards the emotions, thoughts and experiences of others
