



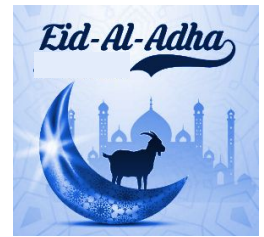

FS2 Learning Pathway

Dear Parents,

Everyone at AAESS would like to wish you and your family a lovely Eid Al Adha holiday and remind you that school will resume as normal on Monday 9th June.



We have recently had a surge in requests to collect students from school early. To enable a student to be picked up early, we require a valid reason to upload to ADEK's eSIS system for the request to be approved. The guidance provided by ADEK is that early leave should only be granted for a medical appointment (but parents should aim to make such appointments during the weekend), a family crisis such as hospitalisation, a family bereavement or for an official community task.

If your child/children are unwell they should be kept at home. If your child has had a stomach upset or sickness it is important that you allow a period of at least 48 hours after the sickness or diarrhoea has finished before sending them back to school. Such action will help to prevent the infection spreading unnecessarily to others in the school. In all cases of your child being unwell and unable to come to school, email the class teacher and the attendance officer at csmith@aaess.sch.ae every day your child is absent ensuring their absence is accounted for.

When contacting staff please remember they have family time outside of school too. Staff are expected to read emails daily (Monday - Friday) and respond within 24 hours. They may choose to read or respond outside of school hours but please do not expect it.

FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 9th June

This week in literacy, we will innovate the story of *The Gingerbread Man*. Combining storytelling, creativity, and writing skills as the children change the story in their own imaginative ways.

During our PSED lessons, we will continue to reflect on our year in FS2 and start to discuss what to expect for the first few days of Year One. We will talk about our feelings and draw and write about our year.

This week in Phonics we will continue to teach and practise the reading and spelling of CVCC/CCVC words, including previously taught digraphs. We will also practise recognition and recall of previously taught graphemes and reading and writing sentences. HFW: your here saw

In maths, we will continue to consolidate previous learning of number bonds recall and exploring numbers to 10.

In understanding the world lessons, we will continue to build on knowledge of past and present as well as revisit and build on previous learning from FS2.
