FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 16th June

In Expressive Art and Design this week based on our story the Monkey Puzzle and our trip to Cheeky Monkeys we will be exploring a variety of materials, tools and techniques to create all kinds of different monkeys.

During our Phonics learning this week, we will practise reading and spelling CCVCC words, such as stand, frost and thank. We will also practise recognition and recall of previously taught graphemes and reading and writing sentences. HFW: time, out, house, about

This week in Maths, we will be consolidating our understanding of subitising (the ability to recognise the number of objects in a small group without counting) and doubling.

In our Understanding the World lessons, in connection with our trip to Cheeky Monkeys, we will be learning all about these fascinating primates this week. What makes them special? Where do they live, and what do they eat? Are there different kinds of monkeys?

In PSED, we will have conversations with peers and adults about our Cheeky Monkeys trip by reviewing the rules on the bus and appropriate behaviour when we are at the venue. We will also focus on navigating our spaces and obstacles carefully, with consideration for themselves and others.

This week in literacy, FS2 will dive into the story *Monkey Puzzle*, focusing on exploring the characters and creating jungle settings through Drawing Club. Children will bring the story to life by drawing detailed scenes from the book and using new vocabulary to describe where Monkey's adventure takes place.
