| Maths | In maths, the children will be learning about coordinates. They will also be exploring position and direction of shapes and how we can explain shapes movements on a grid. |

| English | In English, the children will be exploring different writing features to improve their written work. This will include, capital letter, full stops, similes, personification as well as differentiating between sentence structures. |
| Science | In science, the children will be exploring friction and the effects gravity has upon this. They will be creating a roller coaster made from paper. |
| Integrated Curriculum | In Topic, the children will be delving into information about Victorian life in the factories. The children will be acting as Victorian children applying for jobs in the different factories, as they would have done during this time. |


Reading for pleasure can help to improve student achievement in school. Research has shown that students who read at home do 'significantly better' across the curriculum than students who don't read.


To support our students with their reading choices, we would like to recommend some great books and authors each half term.


