Week beginning: Monday 23rd June

In Expressive Arts and Design this week we will continue with our monkey theme. We will be exploring a variety of materials, tools and techniques, we will be reusing and recycling the materials we have to create all kind of different kind of monkeys.

In PSED, we will continue our conversations about our Cheeky Monkey trip. We will discuss our expectations and review the bus rules again. During our trip, we will focus on navigating our spaces carefully and having plenty of fun!
