To support parents with the transition from Google Classroom to Microsoft Teams, we are pleased to invite you to an introductory training session designed to familiarise parents with the Microsoft Teams system. This session will provide an overview of how to navigate the platform, access learning resources, and support your child's learning at home. Parents of students currently in Preschool – Year 5 are invited in on **Monday 23rd June** at either **7:45 am – 9:00 am** or **2:45 pm – 3:45 pm**.

Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 23rd June

Maths	Continuing on our fractions unit, the children will learn how to compare and order fractions, to count fractions on a number line, and to make links between fractions and scales. Towards the end of the week, the children will take the hot assessment which will cover 2D & 3D shapes, fractions, angles, direction and place value.
English	The children will be continuing to plan their hot assessment story based on the original text of Egyptian Cinderella. They will finish planning their 8 paragraphs and then begin to write up their own version, using the success criteria to show off what they have learnt throughout year 3.
Science	In science we will be revisiting topics and objectives previously taught that the children found challenging. One of the topics is fossils, the children will be learning about the formation of fossils.
Integrated Curriculum	The children will be taking part in a fun team Egyptian quiz against their other classmates, to see what they have remembered this topic. In art, they will be creating a pyramid silhouette painting and Egyptian headdress.

Reading for Pleasure

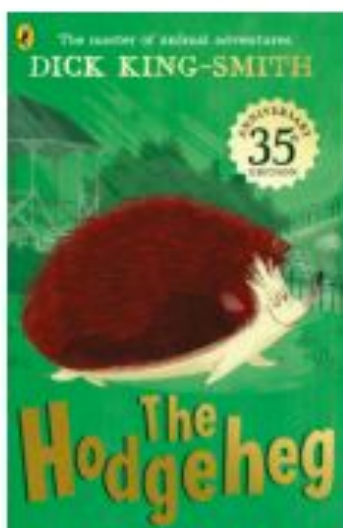
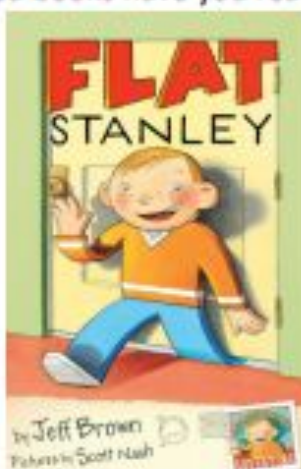
